



## YOUNG ARTIST'S MARKET GUIDELINES

- **NEW!!!!** We will be allowing the Young Artists to enter the Festival 30 minutes before opening each day. This will allow you to set up without dealing with the crowds. You must be wearing your badge to enter. We are firm on the 30 minutes. You will not be allowed in before that time. We hope it will help ease congestion and difficulty setting up with the crowds.
- We are on the 700 block of Broad Street near the Family Stage and Gate 7. You can access the festival through Gate 7 which is the closest to the area.
- Our check in booth will be located on near the Family Stage and close to the Miller Theater. You must check in there ***BEFORE*** setting up your artwork.
- No tents are allowed in the Young Artist's Market and tables must be no larger than a 4x4 foot card table. You may bring chairs for your comfort.
- Only school-aged youth, kindergarten-12<sup>th</sup> grade may participate in the Young Artist's Market.
- There is no supervision from adult chaperones in the Young Artist's Market. If your child is too young to be left unattended, please provide adult supervision for the duration of their sales.
- In consideration of children who may have allergy/asthma issues, we ask that adults with the children refrain from smoking in the area.
- All artists must purchase a badge even if they qualify for free admission due to age. Badges can be purchased in advance for \$5 at Suntrust Bank locations, Vintage Ooollee in downtown Augusta, and New Moon in Aiken. They can also be purchased online at [artsintheheart.com](http://artsintheheart.com). Badges are \$10 at the gate.
- Your admission badge must be purchased and worn before you will be allowed to set up your table.
- You may sell as long as you like. When you leave, please inform the YAM's check-in tent.
- All kinds of artwork are suitable for sales in the Young Artist's Market, but all artwork must be YOUR work. Adults are not permitted to make artwork to sell in this area.
- Be ready for the weather – sunscreen, rain gear if needed. Water bottles and snacks are highly recommended!
